What to Look for in an Industrial Facilities Maintenance Contractor

You should come up with a list of questions that pertain to your needs and expectations and ask the references every one of those questions. They may not have answers for all of them, but they should be able to give you a clearer picture of what it's like to work with the company in question.

3. Sufficient resources to get the job done

The bigger your operation and industrial maintenance needs, the more important it becomes to verify that the maintenance company you use has sufficient resources, which might include equipment, manpower, funding, skilled tradesmen and so on. For example, a smaller company might be well-equipped to address your maintenance needs when you are operating a single, modest-sized plant. But if you are operating a massive plant or multiple plants in various locations, that company might not have the resources to achieve the level of maintenance you want and need.

Some industrial maintenance companies have the capability to scale up to meet the needs of their clients, so you don't necessarily have to rule out a company just because they are not the largest. But you do want to have a discussion early on where you explain the scale of what you need and give them the opportunity to demonstrate that they can meet your requirements.





4. Strong safety record

The industrial maintenance company you choose to partner with will likely be at your facility on a regular – and possibly constant – basis. Every time they arrive on the scene they can represent a potential safety risk for your business and your workers if they are not in compliance with internal and governmental protocols.
